Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
The "Seminar 1: Unemployed Active Citizenship: Time for Activation!" was held from April 24-26, 2024, in Szombathely, Hungary. This seminar aimed to address current labor market challenges, particularly post-COVID-19 trends, and to explore strategies for activating unemployed citizens' participation in the labor market and community.			

On April 24, participants arrived in Szombathely between 12:00 and 18:00 and checked into their accommodations. This was followed by a joint dinner from 19:00 to 21:00, allowing attendees to meet and network in a relaxed setting, setting the tone for the collaborative discussions ahead.

The main sessions began on April 25 at the Westpannon HQ with participant registration from 9:00 to 9:30. The seminar officially opened at 9:30 with welcoming words from the hosting city and organization, along with brief introductions of the attending partners. This introductory session fostered a welcoming and collaborative atmosphere.

From 10:00 to 10:30, a presentation was given on the current issues of the labor market and employment in Hungary, providing a contextual foundation for the day's discussions. This was followed by a session from 10:30 to 11:00 on the role and results of employment pacts in Hungary, highlighting successful initiatives and collaborations aimed at improving employment rates.

At 11:00, a presentation on post-COVID-19 employment trends, with a specific focus on Szombathely, provided insights into the local labor market's recovery and ongoing challenges. This session concluded with a Q&A segment from 11:30 to 12:00, allowing participants to engage directly with the presenters and clarify any questions.

After a lunch break from 12:00 to 13:30, the afternoon session resumed with a presentation from 13:30 to 14:00 on the policy concept of the active social citizen in the EU and Hungary. This was followed by a session from 14:00 to 14:30 on citizen initiatives aimed at involving disadvantaged groups in the labor market, showcasing grassroots efforts and community-driven projects.

From 14:30 to 15:00, participants discussed the successes and failures of local employment policy in Szombathely, providing a critical evaluation of past and current strategies. A Q&A session from 15:00 to 15:30 allowed for further discussion and participant engagement.

After a coffee break from 15:30 to 16:00, the seminar featured a roundtable discussion from 16:00 to 17:00, where participants exchanged knowledge and experiences, brainstorming innovative initiatives to activate citizen participation in the labor market. The day's formal sessions concluded with a summary and closing remarks from 17:00 to 17:30. The evening ended with another joint dinner from 19:00 to 21:00, providing further opportunities for networking and informal discussions among participants.

On the final day, April 26, participants embarked on a city tour from 9:30 to 12:00, exploring Szombathely's historical sites, including Iseum Savariense and Savaria Museum. This cultural experience allowed participants to engage with the local heritage and provided a relaxing conclusion to the seminar. The seminar officially ended with a joint lunch from 12:00 to 13:00, followed by the departure of participants starting at 13:00. This seminar provided a comprehensive platform for discussing labor market challenges, sharing successful initiatives, and fostering active citizenship among the unemployed, within the context of the broader European Union framework.
